Identification Cards

What You Need To Receive An ID Card

A birth certificate and/or Driver's License must be presented to obtain a Maywood Identification Card.

Senior Identification Cards

The Clerk's office issues senior citizen identification cards, including contact person and medical information for Maywood residents. There is no charge for this service.

Voter Services

To register to vote, you can come to the Village Clerk's Office and satisfy the following requirements:

- Two forms of identification, including one that has a picture of yourself.
- You must be at least 18 years old; and you must be a legal resident of the United States.
- You must be a resident of your precinct for at least 30 days prior to an election.
