

ORDINANCE NO. CO-2010-02

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 31.04
(DEPARTMENT OF PLAYGROUNDS AND RECREATION)
OF CHAPTER 31 (DEPARTMENTS, BOARDS, AND COMMISSIONS)
OF THE MAYWOOD VILLAGE CODE
RELATIVE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PLAYGROUNDS AND RECREATION**

WHEREAS, the Village of Maywood is a home rule municipality as defined by Article VII, § 6 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Maywood desire to make certain amendments to the Maywood Village Code to codify the elimination of the Department of Playgrounds and Recreation in response to a November, 2006 referendum expanding the Maywood Park District Village-wide; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the home rule authority granted to home rule municipalities as defined by Article VII, § 6 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Maywood approve the Code Amendments as set forth below.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MAYWOOD, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The above recitals are incorporated as if fully set forth herein as material terms and provisions.

SECTION 2: The portion of the Index to Chapter 31 (Village Departments) of the Maywood Village Code, as set forth below, is amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"Village Departments

31.01 Department of Finance

31.02 Reserved.

31.03 Department of Public Works

31.04 Discontinuation of the Department of Playgrounds and Recreation

31.05 Department of Community Development"

SECTION 3: Chapter 31 (Departments, Boards and Commissions), Section 31.04 (Department of Playgrounds and Recreation) of the Maywood Village Code is amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"§ 31.04 DISCONTINUATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PLAYGROUNDS AND RECREATION.

As of June 11, 2007, the operation and staffing of the Department of Playgrounds and Recreation as one of the regular departments of the Village was discontinued due to the passage of a referendum on November 7, 2006 that approved the expansion of the corporate boundaries of the Maywood Park District through annexation to match the corporate boundaries of the Village. The effect of the referendum is that the Maywood Park District would offer the

recreation activities and operate and maintain recreation facilities for the benefit of the residents of the Village. For purposes of repaying an inter-fund loan made by the Village's General Fund to fund past annual budgets of the Department of Playgrounds and Recreation, the Village will continue to levy approximately \$200,000 per year as part of its annual property tax levy until the inter-fund loan is paid in full."

SECTION 4: All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, to the extent of such conflict, are repealed.

SECTION 5: Each section, paragraph, clause and provision of this Ordinance is separable, and if any provision is held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance, nor any part thereof, other than that part affected by such decision.

SECTION 6: Except as to the Code amendments set forth above in this Ordinance, all Chapters and Sections of the Maywood Village Code, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 7: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
