

**ORDINANCE NO. CO-2014-09**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CREATION AND ISSUANCE OF  
A CLASS "C" LIQUOR LICENSE  
(TEMPORARY SPECIAL EVENT LIQUOR LICENSE  
FOR NON-VILLAGE PROPERTY)  
(Maywood Fine Arts Association - 25 North 5th Avenue)  
(Special Event Date: March 1, 2014)**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Maywood, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** Pursuant to Chapter 117, Section 117.23(C) of the Maywood Village Code, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Maywood authorize the creation of a Class "C" Liquor License in order to allow the Local Liquor Commissioner, in his discretion, to issue the Class "C" Liquor License to the Maywood Fine Arts Association for purposes of allowing the Maywood Fine Arts Association to conduct a special event at the 25 North 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue property on March 1, 2014 (from 7:00 P.M. on March 1, 2014 to 1:00 A.M. on March 2, 2014), or if the event is cancelled or re-scheduled then on one (1) alternate day as determined by the Local Liquor Commissioner, within the Village of Maywood, Illinois ("Special Event"). Maywood Fine Arts Association is the owner of the 25 North 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue property.

**SECTION 2:** The issuance of a Class "C" Liquor License to the Maywood Fine Arts Association, by the Local Liquor Commissioner, for the Special Event is subject to compliance with the following conditions:

- A. The Class "C" Liquor License is valid only on March 1, 2014 (from 7:00 P.M. on March 1, 2014 to 1:00 A.M. on March 2, 2014) or one (1) alternative day in 2014 as approved by the Local Liquor Commissioner for the Special Event and for the first hour of the next day following the Special Event.
- B. Maywood Fine Arts Association shall comply with the applicable provisions of Chapter 117 (Liquor) of the Maywood Village Code, including the Dram Shop Insurance requirement, as well as the other applicable provisions of State law and the Maywood Village Code, including but not limited to the Fire Prevention Code, the Plumbing Code, Building Code, the Property Maintenance Code, Illinois Accessibility Code and the Zoning Code.
- C. All persons who sell or serve alcoholic liquor or handle alcoholic liquor on the licensed premises shall take and successfully complete a Beverage Alcohol Sellers and Servers Education and Training (BASSET) Program that has been certified by the State of Illinois. A copy of the BASSET course completion certificate(s) for each such person shall be made available at all times at the licensed premises for inspection by the Local Liquor Control Commissioner, or his or her designee.
- D. Service and consumption of alcoholic beverages at the Special Event shall be allowed inside the building located at the 25 North 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue property and shall be permitted only from 7:00 P.M. on March 1, 2014 to 1:00 A.M. on March 2, 2014. It shall be illegal to serve or consume alcoholic beverages in violation of the provisions set forth in this Ordinance.

- E. If the Class "C" Liquor License is issued to the Maywood Fine Arts Association, the Class "C" Liquor License may be revoked immediately by the Local Liquor Control Commissioner in the event of a violation of the Maywood Liquor Code regulations or any of the provisions of this Ordinance by the Maywood Fine Arts Association or any of its employees, representatives, agents, guests or contractual service providers.
- F. The Village reserves the right to charge the Maywood Fine Arts Association for special municipal services, such as police, fire and public works personnel and services, that are necessary to protect the health, welfare and safety of the public and those individuals who attend the Special Event. By accepting the issuance of the Class "C" Liquor License, the Maywood Fine Arts Association agrees to pay for such special municipal services provided by the Village, which are necessary to protect the health, welfare and safety of the public and those individuals who attend the Special Event. The charges for such special municipal services, if provided, will be based on the actual out-of-pocket costs incurred by the Village.

**SECTION 3:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval as provided by law.

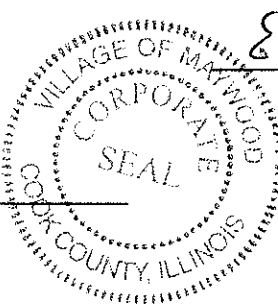

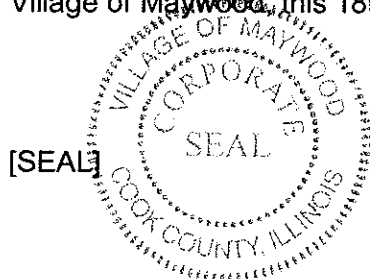
