On Tuesdays and Thursdays from 7am to 9am special hours for shopping have been established.

The Walgreens at 1st and Lake will deliver medication, if you have a credit card on file. The phone number is (708) 344-9885.

Make sure you get at least enough medication to last one month.

The Village Hall is closed to the public. Business can be conducted from the phone, email and mail.

There will be no water shut offs or delinquent penalties placed on utility bills, until after April 30, 2020.
